- Oklahoma County Jail- 201 N. Shartel** Oklahoma County is offering a tour of the Oklahoma County jail. You will see all main operations and will be served lunch in the jail cafeteria which, by law, has to be the same food which is served to the inmates. It will be a truly unique experience. - Positive Tomorrows – (directions will be emailed)** Positive Tomorrows is a private, nonprofit school for homeless children, k-5th grade. Rotarians will tour the school, learn about our programs, and meet some of our students (Host Rotarian: Susan Agel) **Tour Limit 12**
- H & H Gun Range – 400 S. Vermont . –** Proposed tour includes a tour of the range and shooting. -(Host Rotarian: Miles Hall) **Tour Limit: 25**
- BancFirst - 101 N. Broadway.** Tour the downtown operations of BancFirst **Speakers: DAVID RAINBOLT** "The State of Banking in Oklahoma" **and BLANE ALLEN** - "Computer Technology Fraud" (Host Rotarians Jim Daniel, Hank Bradley, David Seat, Tammy Dickson Joe Shockley) **Tour Limit: 25**
- State Capitol Bldg – 23rd & Lincoln Blvd** Highlights tour of our beautiful state capitol. You will have access to the centers of power where our state laws are made and the see the incredible historic art throughout the building. Suggested parking is either south or east of the capitol. If the south lot is full use the east parking and take the tunnel to capitol. In the Capitol, take any elevator to 4th floor and look for your fellow Rotarians in the rotunda under the great dome. - Deaconess Hospital – 5501 N. Portland –** Tour the ER/OR/Labs,. (Host Rotarian – Dr. Ron Sutor) **Tour Limit: 30**
- Okla. History Center – 2401 N. Laird Ave.** Rotarians visiting the Oklahoma History Center will be given an overview of the Center's mission and programs, which have impacted over 920,000 people in its first four years. There will be a brief living history program and an opportunity to ask questions and to explore the Center's exhibits. (Host Rotarian: Jim Waldo) **Tour Limit: 30**
- AAR – 6611 S. Meridian** (at Will Rogers Airport-Proceed to Will Rogers World Airport on S. Meridian. After crossing over SW 54th Street, take the right fork marked by a sign that says "General Aviation." (The left fork is the one that leads to the main terminal. The main offices are in Hangar One at 6611 S. Meridian, approx ½ mile on the right. Address is clearly marked on the streetside sign. Park in the lot and enter the double glass doors under the big AAR logo. Go up the stairs, walk to the end of the hallway and enter the glass doors that say "MRO Group Corporate Offices.") . AAR performs heavy aircraft overhaul and refurbishment for both commercial airline and U.S. government customers in its OKC facility; tour will include a description of the business as well as the opportunity to view aircraft in the process of undergoing extensive repair and hear from the technicians performing the work. - Perimeter Technologies** - NW 39th & Tulsa in OKC – It's Oklahoma's largest and most technologically advanced commercial data center. - Latino Community Development Agency - 420 SW 10th** Tour the facilities – (Host Rotarian- Pat Fennell) **Tour Limit: 15**
- OMRF** – 825 NE 13th St Hear a brief presentation by Dr. Stephen Prescott (President) and get a brief tour of state-of-the-art Animal Facility including the Animal MRI lab. They will also get to meet a couple of our lead scientists during the luncheon. –(Host Rotarian – Penny Voss) **Tour Limit 50**
- OSSM – 1141 N. Lincoln** – Tour the facilities (Host Rotarian – Edna Manning) **Tour Limit: 40+**
- YMCA Military Welcome Center** at Will Rogers World Airport (The Center is located outside the east end of the baggage claim area.) The Center serves 35,000 military personnel annually and provides them with a comfortable environment in which to relax with complimentary snacks and beverages, internet access, cell phones, books, video games, television etc. (Host Rotarian – Mike Grady) **Tour Limit: 48**
- Calm Waters 4334 NW Expressway** West of Integris Hospital off NW Expressway, past Portland. CW is in the NW Office Center, located at 4334 NW Expressway, Suite 101 and is on the south side of the highway, between Jason's Deli and the OKC First Church of the Nazarene. We have a West entrance. (Do not enter the main office building entrance) Additional parking is available on the west side of the building or at the church (Host Rotarian – Barbara Butner) **(Tour limit – 30)**
- TEEM -14 NE 13th St.** one block east of 13th & Broadway on the southwest corner of 13th & Oklahoma. Parking is in the lot one block north at 14th & Oklahoma. Tour the facilities (Host Rotarian Tony Zahn) **Tour Limit: 12**
- THE CHILDREN'S ZOO AT THE OKC ZOO:** 2101 N.E. 50th Street. Be one of the first to discover the Oklahoma City Zoo's new Children's Zoo. The Children's Zoo was designed just to “choose your own adventure” format, with lots of trails and individual play spaces. Explore the Underground to uncover fun creepy crawlies.
